SoundVision Sweeps ‘Best Home Theater’ Category at 2009 NARI Remmie Awards

NOVATO, Calif., — Feb. 1, 2010 — SoundVision, the North Bay’s leader in advanced home entertainment and automation systems, announced today that the company took home two First Place and two Second Place Remmie Awards in the Best Home Theater category from the Bay Area chapter of the National Association of the Remodeling Industry (NARI). Held annually, the Remmie Awards recognize outstanding achievement in the residential remodeling industry in a variety of categories, including kitchens, bathrooms, interiors, exteriors and general excellence.

“It’s an honor to receive not one, but four NARI Remmie Awards,” said Scott Sullivan, president and owner of SoundVision. “Our thanks go to the NARI Remmies committee for recognizing our work again this year.”

2009 is the third consecutive year that SoundVision has taken home top honors in the Best Home Theater category of the Bay Area NARI Remmies competition. This year’s award-winning SoundVision projects include:

- **Best Home Theater Over \$150,000 – First Place:** Working alongside architecture firm Andrew Skurman Architects, general contractor Cove Construction, interior designer Martha Angus and lighting designer Anna Kondolf, SoundVision designed and installed several media room systems as part of a new home construction project in San Francisco’s Pacific Heights neighborhood. The systems SoundVision installed included a disappearing home theater in the home’s study, featuring a motorized projection screen and high-definition projector hidden behind a piece of artwork on a motorized lift. Both the screen and artwork lower when the system is initialized via a Crestron wireless touchpanel.
- **Best Home Theater Over \$150,000 – Second Place:** SoundVision worked with architecture firm Walker Werner, general contractor RedHorse Constructors and interior designer Sally Ward to install another disappearing home theater system in this home remodeling project in Corte

Madera. Located in a former home music studio, SoundVision installed a custom ceiling lift to completely conceal a high definition projector, and a motorized projection screen retracts into the ceiling when the theater system is not in use.

- **Best Home Theater Under \$150,000 – First Place:** The clients wanted a complete theater system in their new Belvedere home, but they did not want to dedicate a room specifically for a home theater. Working with architecture firm Hank Bruce Architects, general contractor Landmark Builders, interior designer Ann Peck and lighting designer Eric Johnson and Associates, SoundVision designed and installed a disappearing theater system in the home’s living room. This system features a motorized 103-inch projection screen that drops from the ceiling, and a high-definition projector concealed behind a piece of moveable artwork.
- **Best Home Theater Under \$150,000 – Second Place:** SoundVision designed and installed an elegant new media system for clients who were remodeling their home in Novato, centering around a 55-inch Samsung ultra-thin LCD TV mounted above the home’s fireplace.

In 2008, SoundVision also captured the first-place Remmie Award in the Best Green Home category for our work on the “Zero Energy Home” in Tiburon, which was featured in the *San Francisco Chronicle* and *Electronic House Magazine*, as well as the first-place Best Home Theater award for another project in Tiburon.
